	01 Follow the 1 in - 1 out rule! When a new toy comes in, an unused or broken one goes.	02 Toss puzzles/games that are missing pieces.	03 Donate/sell puzzles and games kids have outgrown but are still usable.	04 Toss broken toys.	05 Declutter shoes (toss damaged and donate outgrown ones).	06 Bag up and donate outgrown clothes.
07 Sort and box up hand-me-up clothes. Store in tight-fitting clear storage tubs in garage, attic, closet, or under bed.	08 Declutter, donate or sell belts and ties that are too small. Store remainder on clothes hanger using shower curtain rings.	09 Donate toys/dolls no longer played with.	10 Organize Legos by color or set. Store in zip top clear bags, clear shoe boxes or over the door shoe bag.	11 Organize small toys/dolls & their accessories by set. Store in zip top clear bags, clear shoe boxes or over the door shoe bag.	12 Declutter unwanted stuffed animals. Store rest in a large tub or as bean bag chair "fill."	13 For more toy storage, tack a fitted crib sheet up in a corner to make a toy hammock.
14 Donate/toss no longer used nursery supplies: bedding, diaper bags, burp cloths, bibs. Repurpose old cribs	15 Donate or sell unused sports equipment.	16 Donate/sell outgrown bedding, linens, and sleeping bags	17 Donate/sell outgrown/no longer wanted seasonal items - snow pants, boots, swimwear, life jackets.	18 Donate or toss old art supplies like dried up paint, play-doh and markers, worn paintbrushes. Recycle old crayons into art.	19 Remove and recycle worn out batteries from electronics and toys.	20 Donate/sell DVDs, CDs and video games kids have outgrown but are still usable.
21 Use a hanging cubby in closet to store a week's worth of school clothes.	22 Have a hamper for each child. Clip a zippered lingerie bag on it to hold dirty socks. No more sorting socks!	23 Add an extra hanging rod and double kids' closet space.	24 Add clothing pictures to dresser drawers so non-readers can put their own clothes away.	25 Use magazine file boxes to hold small papers, books, and schoolwork.	26 Add picture wire and clips or a bulletin or magnetic board for kids to display their artwork on.	27 Take all donations to your various destinations today! Don't forget to get a donation form, fill it out with what you donated and put in your tax folder.
28 Use Command hooks on short side of closet to hang backpacks and sports bags.	29 Mount a piece of painted pegboard to the wall to store small items or accessories on hooks or in bins/baskets	30 Make an art caddy to store school or art supplies.
